

In the beginning of April the InduCult2.0 partners met up in Italy. Together with their stakeholders they were introduced to the industrial spirit of Padova during several study tours. The tour guides of the Glass School at Murano and the Steel Factory of Padova very passionately described the rich industrial past of the region as well as how the present labour force is taken along in the industrial transition. At the Polytechnic School (in the shoe district) focus is clearly on the link between traditional and future
