









1. FLOP SHOW FESTIVAL

On November 4th, 2023 Regional Development Agency "ARLEG" S.A. participated in the Festival of Legnica NGOs FLOP SHOW. The festival was organized by the PRO LEGNICA Association under the patronage of the Mayor of the City. The festival is a local celebration of non-governmental organizations, which, thanks to their participation, can present their activities and their offer, which is very often addressed to the local community.



















For ARLEG, it was an opportunity to present to festival attendees the goals of the international 3P4SSE project "Public-Private Partnership for Social and Solidarity Economy," which promotes cooperation to









reduce social inequality in Central Europe and increase cohesion between economic sectors and the disadvantaged.


2. CONFERENCES IN THE FRAMEWORK OF INTERREG PROGRAMMES:

In the last six months ARLEG participated in two conferences organized by the Ministry of Funds and Regional Policy as part of the campaign to promote the offer of Interreg programmes: Interreg Central Europe, Interreg Europe and Interreg Baltic Sea Region. The agenda of the Conferences included issues related to the planned calls for proposals. This was also an opportunity to promote ongoing projects and exchange project experiences.

The conference "Local Challenges, International Solutions" took place on 21 November, 2023 in Katowice. For ARLEG is was an opportunity to promote the 3P4SSE project objectives in the form of a power point presentation displayed on screens in the meeting rooms, through a project roll-up in the main hall and project posters, leaflets distributed among participants.



















The second conference "Time for Cooperation - Interreg Programmes in Lower Silesia" was held on March 7^{th} , 2024 in Wroclaw. Institutions and organizations participating in the event had the opportunity to learn about the benefits and practical aspects of preparing and implementing partnership projects in Lower Silesia region in the context of the planned calls for proposals.

Beneficiaries of Interreg Programmes, also presented inspiring examples of ongoing projects. They shared their experiences of implementing projects and talked about the benefits of international cooperation.

In the current perspective of the Interreg Central Europe Program, 100 projects have so far been approved in two calls for proposals with funding of €175.5 million, 16 of which involve partners from Lower Silesia. ARLEG, implementing the #3P4SSE project, is one of them.



















3. VIRTUAL STUDY VISIT IN POLAND (ON-LINE)

On December 5, 2023 the Regional Development Agency "ARLEG" S.A. jointly with the Lower Silesian Social Policy Center, organized a virtual study visit, which was attended by project partners and stakeholders. The study visit was entitled: "Social and solidarity economy in Lower Silesia - legal framework and good practices".

Participants were acquainted with the legal framework for social and solidarity economy at the national and regional levels in force in Poland. Two examples of well-functioning cooperation networks were also presented:

- 1) Partnership for the Barycz Valley a public-private partnership working in Lower Silesia for the development of education, tourism, local producers and natural monuments of the Barycz Valley area,
- 2) PANATO BAG a network of social economy enterprises employing people with disabilities, producing bags, backpacks and advertising accessories for the domestic and foreign markets.




















4. ON-LINE WORSHOP: "Local policy priorities in the area of social and solidarity economy and public-private partnerships"

On January 25th, 2024 ARLEG organized a local workshop with the Lower Silesian Social Policy Center to prioritize local policies defined in earlier stages of the project. The workshop was attended by representatives of: the Marshal's Office of the Lower Silesian Voivodeship, the Social Economy Support Center, the Lower Silesian Social Welfare Forum and the Social Welfare Center, as well as representatives of formal and informal networks of cooperation between the public, private, non-governmental and social sectors. Prior to the prioritization, the Italian and Slovenian model of cooperation of entities in the field of social economy was presented to the participants of the meeting, so that they could take inspiration from good practices derived from the partner countries of the 3P4SSE project.




















In addition to the activities outlined above, ARLEG together with project partners participated in two international Workshops organized by project Leader on February 16th, 2024 and Match 15th, 2024.
