Since October 2023 we are implementing the Life project:
Expanding the range of the lynx population in northern Poland.




The estimated population size at the end of 2023 was **90** lynx individuals

Half of living individuals were **born in the wild**

2019 – first year of releasing lynx, female - Cleo gave the birth


2020 –Cleo's second reproduction, two more female had kittens

Female Luna gave the birth and raised the kittens out side the forest






Genetic confirmation of reproduction of male born in the wild in 2020

Two, born in 2022 in the wild female gave the birth


